Baruch will be your primary teacher with Naftali Cohen as your licensed guide. Mr. Cohen will provide historical and background information throughout the tour, and Baruch will teach at each site.

The tour price is Land ONLY. Our constituency, friends and partners come from all over the world and not just one city. This means:

[Flight arrangements:](#) Each tour participant is required to make his or her own flight arrangements and arrive at the InterContinental David Hotel in Tel Aviv on November 16; checking in at around 3:00 pm.

[A beautiful coach will be provided](#) during the tour for the group's travel needs. Israel is a small country. There are no bathrooms on the bus; however the bus makes frequent stops throughout the day.

ISRAEL STUDY TOUR ITINERARY NOVEMBER 16-NOVEMBER 25, 2026



Day 1: Monday November 16, You are responsible to arrive at our Hotel (Intercontinental David Hotel- Tel Aviv) after 3:00 pm. Taxis to the hotel are approximately 225 Israeli shekels. Kindly check in and enjoy the beautiful surroundings until our Group Meeting at 6:00 pm.

Please meet in the lobby at 5:55 pm and you will be directed to our meeting room where Baruch and Rivka will welcome you and provide important information concerning this Study Tour. We will eat dinner together at 7:00 pm and after that we will walk to [ancient Yafo](#). We will arrive back to the Hotel at approximately 10:30 pm.

Day 2: Tuesday November 17, We will depart at 8:00 am for [Caesarea](#), one of the most beautiful Biblical sites. It is along the Mediterranean coast and figured significantly in the work of Paul and was the location where the first Gentile received the Gospel.

[Megiddo](#) (Biblical Armageddon). Here we will study the end times and why this location will hold such an important role in the Last Days.



[Mount Carmel](#), This is the location where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal and G-d revealed Himself to be the One True G-d. Elijah had hoped this manifestation of G-d's power would bring a spiritual revival to Israel, but unfortunately the outcome was far less than this. We will discuss this section of the Bible and some of the principles related to revival.

We will arrive at our Galilean hotel in the [ancient city of Tzfat](#), Ruth Rimonim. This will be our base for the next three nights. After dinner we will explore the Old City together.

One of the reasons for staying in Tzfat is that this city provides our group the opportunity to explore in the evening a type of “Little Jerusalem”. This mountain top city holds a most significant place in the history and development of Judaism. The setting of Tzfat is stunning and one will think that he or she has returned to the 16th century, which represented the “Golden Age” of Tzfat.



Day 3: Wednesday November 18, Depart at 8:00 am for [Kfar Nachum \(Capernaum\)](#). This site was the location for Yeshua's ministry headquarters. We will thoroughly explore the ruins of this ancient village. We will discuss some of the important events that occurred there and further our understanding of Yeshua's teachings and deeds.



We will then take a boat ride on the [Sea of Galilee](#) and learn some of the significant events that took place near or even on this lake.



We will then move on to our next site, [Beit Tzaida](#). This is one of the three cities which Yeshua cursed for their unbelief. We will study two key miracles related to this city.

Next stop will be [Kursi](#). The name of this National Park is derived from the Talmud. Here we will study the miracle of casting demons from a man into a herd of pigs. We will be talking about demonic possession and why believers can never be possessed by a demon.

Our last stop is [Mt. Arbel](#). Here we will talk about the Roman wars and how the ancient Jewish community suffered due to Roman oppression and war being declared upon the Jewish people.

Overnight: Tzfat: Ruth Rimonim (B & D)



Day 4: Thursday November 19, Depart at 8:00 am for [Hazor](#) to hear about Joshua's conquest of the Land.

We will then travel to the [Golan Heights](#) and visit [Caesarea Philippi \(Banias\)](#) where Peter confessed that Yeshua is the Messiah. We will learn why this event occurred at this location.



Then we will move further up on the Golan Heights and will visit [Nimrod's Fortress](#). These spectacular ruins provide a dramatic view of the Golan Heights. Also known as Nimrod's Castle, which is located at the foot of Mt. Hermon, this site is the largest Medieval castle in Israel and represents a time when knights ruled and there was great conflict between believers and Islam. Our purpose, however, is to discuss the Biblical significance of Mt. Hermon and Paul's repentance as he traveled to Damascus.



Our next stop is an [overlook of Syria](#) and we will learn about Paul's Damascus Road experience and have a special guest lecturer to give us an update on security issues (both past and present).

Our last stop is the [Talmudic Village](#). Located in the Golan Heights, this is an excellent representation of the Talmudic period. We will discuss life at this time and a few traditional Jewish law matters.

Overnight: Tzfat: Ruth Rimonim (B & D)



Day 5: Friday November 20, Depart 8:00 am for [Beit She'an](#). At this location we will study King Saul and learn about the Roman occupation of Israel in the latter Second Temple period. This is an impressive archeological site.

We will then travel down to [Gilgal](#), which is where the children of Israel observed the Passover after crossing the Jordan river and entering in to the land of Canaan. There they prepared themselves to keep the Passover by circumcizing all the men in order for them to do the Passover. We will focus on Joshua chapter 5.




Next is the [Jordan River valley](#) where John would have been baptizing . You will have an opportunity to immerse. If you are going to immerse, please make sure you are wearing modest attire. Dark colors, shorts and top, with a swimming suit underneath. This is not the place where most groups visit. This is actually located in a military area. It is an authentic location in the [Kikar HaYardin](#). We will study much there concerning the history of immersion both from a traditional viewpoint (Judaism) and from the perspective of the New Covenant.

We then will proceed by Jericho and begin our ascent to the [Holy City of Jerusalem](#). We will stop at [Mt. of Olives overlook](#). This is both the site of Yeshua's ascension and one of the places to which He will return. While visiting the Mt. of Olives, we will discuss some End Time issues.

Then we will welcome Shabbat together and enjoy a traditional Shabbat dinner. After dinner we will meet for our Erev Shabbat worship service.

Day 6: Saturday November 21, Depart from the hotel heading to the [Old City](#). We will have a full day in Jerusalem walking to many sites to visit significant Biblical locations, such as: Visit the [House of Caiphas](#), where Yeshua was tried by the Sanhedrin. Also, We will go to the [City of David](#) to walk through [Hezekiah's Tunnel](#) (wet or dry tunnel- bring a flashlight!) and study about the Pool where the blind man was healed in John chapter 9.



Another important place is [Gabta](#), where the Roman soldiers gambled for Yeshua's garment. This place is very near to where Pontius Pilate certified that Yeshua was the man who was brutally flogged prior to His crucifixion.

Lastly we will visit [Avshalom's Pillar](#), [Garden of Gethsemane](#) and [Bet Chesed](#).

Overnight:Jerusalem: Dan Panorama:(B&D)



Day 7: Sunday November 22, Depart from the hotel heading for the [Dead Sea](#). We will visit [Ein Gedi](#) and study about the book of Song of Songs and King David hiding out from Saul at this location. We plan to give some time to float in the Dead Sea before moving on to [Masada](#) and learn about Israel's history during the Roman period.

While enjoying our visit to the Dead Sea area, we will not only hear the events which took place at Masada, but also learn the significance of the Dead Sea Scrolls during our tour of [Qumran](#).

On our way back we will stop at [Tel Arad](#), an ancient site located in the southern Negev Desert. This is where we will discuss Numbers chapter 21.

Later, at [Tel Beer Sheva](#), the southernmost city of ancient Israel, we will focus on this city and what the Scripture says concerning it.

Day 8: Monday November 23, Depart 8:00 am. The high point for time in Jerusalem is always our visit to the [Garden Tomb](#) where we study about the Death, Burial and Resurrection of Yeshua. There we will have an in-depth study of Passover in order to learn when these key events actually took place and their significance. We will also partake of the Lord's Supper together at this location and learn why it is called by this name.



We will then head to the [Western Wall](#) and tour the [Western Wall tunnel](#). From there we will go to [Gilo](#) to [overlook Bethlehem](#).

From there we will head to the [Davidson Center](#) and the [City Of David](#).

Overnight: Jerusalem: Dan Panorama: (B & D)



Day 9: Tuesday November 24, Depart 8:00 am for [Yad Vashem](#), This is Israel's Holocaust Museum. After visiting this location, we will discuss the implications of Jeremiah 30:7 and what Israel will suffer in the End Times.

[Valley of Elah \(up above\) Tel Azakah](#), This is the location where the battle between David and Goliath took place. We will discuss this passage and focus on practical application that is derived from this account.

Lastly, we will head to the [Tombs of Samson and Samuel](#). These two men represent very different characters but nevertheless G-d used both of them to bless Israel.
