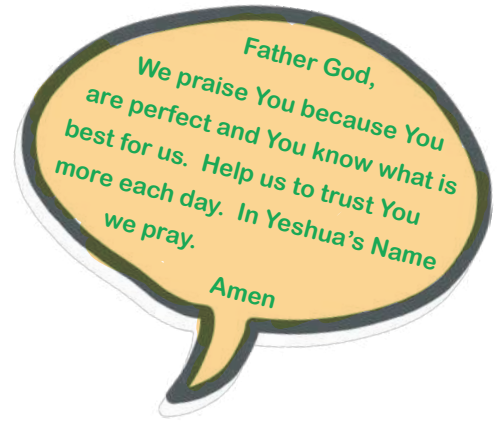

Do you know that God has a perfect plan for your life?

GENESIS

In Genesis 6:9, we learn that Noach walked with God. In Genesis 6:18, God told Noach that he would be saved because he was righteous. Because Noach was righteous, or had faith in God, God did not destroy him with His judgment. God saved Noach and his family from the flood.



In Genesis 7-8, we learn that Noach and his wife, his sons, their wives, and many animals went into the ark and God closed the door. After God closed the door, it began to rain. It rained for 40 days and 40 nights. After everything was destroyed, Noach came out of the ark and built an altar to worship God who had saved him and his family.

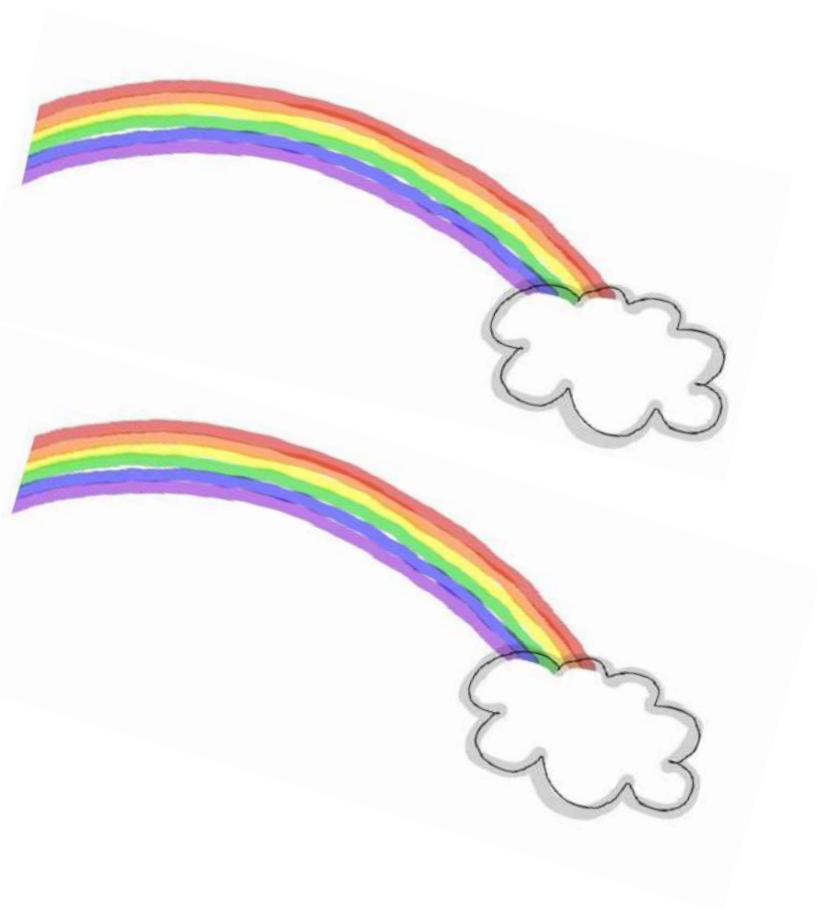
Remember, God is a God of order. His order is perfect. God knows what's best!

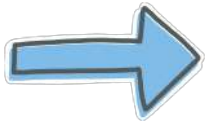

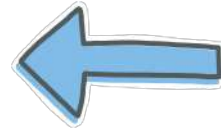

In **John 10:9** YESHUA SAYS, "I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture."

In **John 14:6** YESHUA SAYS, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."

In these Bible verses, Messiah Yeshua (Jesus Christ) tells us He is the only way to God.

When Noah went into the ark, there was only one door to enter and only those on the ark were saved from God's judgment. Messiah Yeshua is like the door to the ark. He is the only way to enter into the presence of God the Father. Only those who are in His presence will be saved from His judgment because of sin.
